It is now an independent non-profit making corporation entity with a broader health mandate, wider geographical focus continuing to build on, and leverage on her core competencies in the field of HIV/AIDS and related health conditions.

ACHAP seeks to appoint suitably qualified and highly motivated individuals with strong commitment to programme implementation to the following position:

**District Supervisors - Youth Programme** (5 positions tenable in Palapye, Selebi Phikwe, Francistown, Tutume and Maun)

### **Job Purpose:**

The incumbent will be responsible for providing Peer Education Mentors with support and encouragement needed to ensure successful program delivery.

### **Principal Accountabilities**

- Supports peer educators/mentors on their day to day program implementation with guidance of the Senior Program Officer-Youth
- Helps prepare for the Youth Module trainings (Parent Child communication, Peer Educators' training)
- Works closely with the Senior Program Officer-Youth, the AGYW Officer and Peer Education Mentors to strengthen knowledge and awareness of youths and adolescents on HIV testing, Voluntary Medical Male Circumcision (VMMC) and Sexual Reproductive Health and Rights (SRHR) based on government-approved comprehensive sexual education guidelines
- Prepares and participates in all demand creation activities for the youth module
- Prepares and participates in a range of Youth Module events, including seminars with parents, teachers, religious leaders and elders to teach and advocate on adolescent SRHR and gender; parent and child dialogues; and radio events
- Liaises with district structures to ensure successful implementation of Youth program activities and linkages to services for clients
- Receives/collects data, keeps records and ensures reporting within the district structures and to ACHAP HQ is done in a timely manner
